Administrative Matters and Announcements: Ellie Lonske, Chair, called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. She appointed Alternates Joe Hogan and Arthur Cummings as a voting member for the hearing. The minutes of the June 1, 2011 meeting were discussed. Bruce Barnard had notified Ms. Lonske by e-mail that the minutes incorrectly stated that he had volunteered and Ms. Lonske had authorized him to handle recording the Site Plan for Camp Mowglis Staff Housing. In fact, Mr. Barnard had requested a written waiver of recordation of the Mowglis plan, and the waiver had been granted by the Planning Board.

Curtis Mooney moved and Joe Hogan seconded a motion to adopt the minutes of June 1, 2011 as corrected. Motion passed unanimously.

Arthur Cummings moved and Joe Hogan seconded a motion to adopt the minutes of the June 20, 2011 Joint Work Session with the Hebron Conservation Commission. Motion passed unanimously.

Continuance of Sughrue Portion of George Road Relocation: Ms. Lonske reported that she had received an e-mail on July 6, 2011 from Alan Barnard requesting a continuance until the August meeting for this matter. The continuance was granted.
