

OPTIONS FOR THE DISPOSAL OF TRASH FOR HEBRON

(Arranged alphabetically)

1. BESTWAY DISPOSAL SYSTEMS

Cost \$67,000 per year. Bestway will provide 18 gallon recycling bins for single stream recycling. User provides container for rubbish. (Single stream means that you do not separate items such as glass, plastics, paper, etc., but it is done off site at a facility designed for that purpose)

PROS: Convenient, no travel involved, no need to separate, 5-year contract

CONS: One day only per week, possible animal problems (bear, raccoons etc), icy weather may be a problem. Weekenders only have one weekday for trash removal.

2. BRISTOL TRANSFER STATION

Cost \$30,000 per year. Single stream disposal. (recycled off site). Household garbage is dropped off at the upper station and C&D (construction and demolition), debris, metals, burnable items, appliances, propane tanks, leaves, and wood products at the lower station. C&D is charged by the cubic yard.

PROS: Single stream, open Mon., Wed., & Sat. (possibly Sun.), 5-year contract
No need to separate

CONS: 5 miles farther than H-B. (from Jct of 3-A and N Shore Road)

3. PLYMOUTH RECYCLING CENTER

Cost \$51,000 per year. Separate on site. 5-year contract. C&D charged by the ton

PROS: Recycle on site, open Tues., Thurs., Fri., Sat., & Sun. 5 year contract
More people usually go to Plymouth
More closely resembles H-B set-up
Open more days than others

CONS: 5 miles farther than H-B. (from Jct of 3-A and N Shore Road)

4. WHITCHER, CM RUBBISH REMOVAL LLC

Cost \$35,000 per year. \$20,000 plus \$75 per ton, 3-year contract (200 ton estimate)

PROS: Convenient, no travel involved, 3-year contract, user provides container for rubbish

CONS: One day only per week, possible animal problems (bear, raccoons etc), icy weather may be a problem. Weekenders only have one weekday for trash removal. No recycling.

5. COMBINATION OF BRISTOL AND WHITCHER RUBBISH REMOVAL LLC

COST \$65,000 PER YEAR.

PROS: Provides a choice for each household, 3-5 year contract
Each household could use either or both options
Weekenders have two options for trash removal

CONS: Only those listed above for the same service.

6. HEBRON-BRIDGEWATER REFUSE DISTRICT

Hebron offered to pay \$75,000 annually to continue using the District if we withdraw
The offer was denied twice by Bridgewater. They insist on Hebron paying \$250,000
