NHACC Legislative update

Senate and House bills were reviewed, and Cons Comms are being invited to comment of a number of bills. The HCC discussed each bill, and agreed with the assessment by the NHACC. Paul Connor moved, Barb seconded a directive for the HCC to comment on several that had hearings scheduled, including:

- Oppose requiring public benefit and community impact assessments from NHDES HB 1170,
- Support Addition of cyanobacteria to NH clean lakes program HB 1143,
- Support prohibition of certain phosphorous fertilizers HB 1293,
- Oppose prohibiting NH from enforcing EPA regulations HB 1294,
- Support for adding provisions to the state development plan about protection of natural resources and identifying environmental threats HB 1314.

Motion passed unanimously.

Budget

Martha will present the HCC 2024-25 draft budget to the SB in Feb. Barb made a motion and Paul seconded to submit a budget of \$5,000 as we did for this fiscal year. Vote was unanimous.

Bocce Court

Barb said the Town Green Committee is raising money to fund a new bocce court that is flush with the lawn. Merrill's estimate is \$1,200.00. Several individuals have made donations, and Barb asked if the Hebron Cons Comm could make a donation, all concurred the court is a benefit to the residents, and is used often in three seasons. Barbara made a motion to donate \$200.00 to the Bocce Court Improvement project, Paul seconded, unanimous.
