9:00 A.M. **NON-PUBLIC SESSION:** Chair Moriarty moved to enter into non-public session pursuant to NH RSA 91-A: 3, II(a) to perform the annual reviews on employees, seconded by Vice-Chair Dunklee. Pat Moriarty — yes John Dunklee — yes and Ellie Lonske — yes

9:46 A.M. **REVIEW OF THE 2016 BUDGET AND WARRANT ARTICLES FOR THE PUBLIC HEARING:** Member Lonske discussed with the Board organizing transportation to Town Meeting which will be held in the Town of Bridgewater. Member Lonske informed the Board that the company she had contacted does not require a lot of notice for providing a van for transportation. Member Lonske noted that she would be placing an article in the Hebron newsletter on contacting the office if transportation would be required in order to get an idea of the amount of people that need transportation. Member Lonske asked Mrs. Corliss to obtain written confirmation from the SAU4 Office and the Bridgewater-Hebron Village School for reserving the gymnasium for the Annual Meeting.

The Board reviewed the warrant articles proposed for the public hearing and the recommendations for changes to the articles from Michelle Clark (representative with the Department of Revenue Administration). Mrs. Corliss relayed to the Board that Avitar Associates of New England, Inc. recommended to the towns considering adopting a solar energy exemption before the systems would be assessed in the future. The Board decided not to adopt the exemption at this time.

The Board agreed to meet at the Hebron Community Hall on Tuesday, January 19, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. to prepare for the Public Hearing.

The Board discussed scheduling the Merrill's for setting up for the NH Primary to be held on February 9, 2016. Elections will be held in the Hebron Community Hall.

The Board discussed adding a count by the *Recommended by Selectmen* under the warrant articles since the Board did not vote unanimously on one of the articles.
