MARCH 8, 2016

PRESENT: Pat Moriarty, John Dunklee, Ellie Lonske, and Karen Corliss, Town Administrator

2:30 P.M. **ACCOUNTING MANIFEST:** The Select Board signed the accounting manifest.

2:35 P.M. **HEBRON-BRIDGEWATER VILLAGE DISTRICT – REMEDIATION COST RESPONSIBILITY:** Chair Moriarty discussed with the Board moving forward to schedule a meeting with the Hebron-Bridgewater Refuse Facility Commissioners and the NH Department of Environmental Services (NH DES) regarding the remediation costs for the facility. The Board discussed the concerns brought to Chair Moriarty from Commissioner Terry Murphy about meeting with the NH DES without the knowledge of the testing being done and how NH DES processes the reports. Vice-Chair Dunklee stated that it had been the policy of the Select Board in the past that copies of the reports from the engineers performing testing at the Hebron-Bridgewater Refuse Facility be submitted along with the invoicing. All invoices were held until the information was provided. Chair Moriarty expressed concerns that the Town of Hebron would be obligated financially for an unknown amount of time for the testing of the ash pit if NH DES did not set a timeframe for the testing to be completed. Chair Moriarty would like to establish an end date to the requirements for the testing with NH DES. Chair Moriarty agreed to set up a meeting with the Hebron-Bridgewater Refuse Facility Commissioners to discuss the progress being made with the testing of the ash pit and then meet with NH DES to determine what the department is looking for in order for the ash pit to be considered environmentally sound.

2:40 P.M. **MEETING ADJOURNED:** Member Lonske moved to adjourn the meeting at 2:40 p.m., seconded by Vice-Chair Dunklee. The vote was unanimous.
