SUPERVISORS OF THE CHECKLIST MEETING MINUTES

Saturday - October 25, 2014 - 0900 Hours

The three Supervisors met on the second floor of the Selectmen's Office Bldg. to make any corrections necessary to the checklist prior to the upcoming State General Elections on Nov. 4, 2014.

After reviewing the outcome of the 30day letters that were mailed on Sept. 17, 2014 the following corrections were made to the checklist by majority vote. (ITEMIZED LIST ATTACHED AND FILED)

Two persons receiving 30 day letters submitted proof of residence and were retained on the checklist. Thirty-two persons were determined to no longer be residing in Hebron and were removed. Six new applications were received and added with an additional voter coming in person on the 25th to register.

As of Oct. 25th, there are 417 registered voters in Hebron. They are divided as follows:

REPUBLICANS - 172, UNDECLARED - 201, DEMOCRATS - 44

Other Business:

NEWSPAPER ADS: We have a new free newspaper being distributed in the Newfound Area. The Ad discussion center around whether to put our meeting ad in both papers. We are currently paying \$81 per ad to the Plymouth Record. It was decided we could place our ad in both papers by reducing the size of the present ad to a 2X2 making it possible to put the same ad in both papers for approx. the same cost we are currently incurring.

BUDGET: The budget was reviewed and adjusted for 2015. The Superviros will be presenting it to the Selectmen on Nov. 19 at 1315 hrs.

It was voted in the majority to meet to execute post election business on Nov. 6, 2014 at 0915 hrs. upstairs in the Selectmen's Building. There will be no newspaper notification of this meeting.

MEETING MINUTES

SUPERVISOR OF THE HEBRON CHECKLIST

Thursday, November 06, 2014 - 09:00 Hrs.

The Supervisors met to calculate the post election figures and to compile the reports required by the State of New Hampshire. On Nov. 4th, election day, there were eleven new Hebron Voters registered, several address changes and two previously registered Hebron Voters voted elsewhere in the State.

After the additions and corrections the up-to-date checklist figures are as follows:

Total Voters on the Checklist **428**

176 Republicans – 46 Democrats – 206 Undeclared

OTHER BUSINESS: It was unanimously voted for the convenience of Hebron Residents to keep a current checklist in the glass case outside the Town Clerk's Office. This location was chosen because new voters can register at their convenience with the Town Clerk during regular office hours.

A final decision was unanimously voted with regard to newspaper public notices. It was decided notices will be placed in two newspapers, the Newfound News and the Record Enterprise. It was also voted to decrease the size of the ads to 2 column width by 2", at a cost of \$46.00 for both, an overall savings to Hebron of \$35.00 for each submission. Paper meeting notices, when timely are also placed outside the Selectmen's Office, outside the Town Clerk/Tax Collector's Offices, in the Post Office and on the Town Web Site.

The next scheduled public meeting of the Supervisors to make additions and corrections to the checklist will be January 20, 2015 between 7:00 and 7:30 PM on the second floor of the Selectmen's Office.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:30 Hrs.
