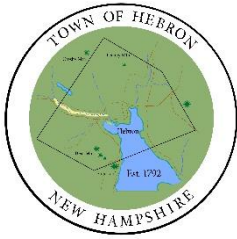

Minutes of Meeting May 21, 2019

Paul Hazelton called the meeting to order at 7:03. The first order of business was the election of a Chair Person for the following year. Roger Larochelle moved to nominate Ronald Collins as Chair seconded by Chris Laux. The vote was in the affirmative with all voting in favor.

Ronald Collins moved to elect David Brittelli as Vice Chair and this was seconded by Roger Larochelle. The vote was in the affirmative with all voting in favor.

Minutes: The minutes of the November 13, 2018 were reviewed and there was a small change under new business. A motion was made by Roger Larochelle to approve the minutes with the necessary changes and seconded by Chris Laux. The motion passed in the affirmative.

New Business:

Next on the agenda was the request for installation of a 10.4 kw Photovoltaic Solar System at 19 Cross Road Map: 17 Lot 15 on the roof of the garage. There is currently a solar system located on a property located off Braley Road, which is in the historic district. This system blended in with the surrounding of the property.

The system that would be located on the property at 19 Cross Road would be black and would blend in with the roof of the garage. There was discussion about the reflection off the panels could be an issue but where the panels were black thought it would not be a problem.

There was representation by the neighbors and they were in favor of this project. Phyllis Rockwell indicated the savings on electric is well worth having the system installed as they have one located at their property on Hunt Road.

Other Business:

Roger talked about the composition of the committee as he is representing the Planning Board and he will no longer be Chair of the Planning Board. Ron indicated that the Chair is the person that represents the Historic District. The new Planning Board Chair will be elect at the next Planning Board meeting in June.
