TOWN OF HEBRON SELECT BOARD MEETING MINUTES MAY 15, 2019

- 12:00 P.M. UPDATE ON ACADEMY BUILDING CONSTRUCTION: Bryant Lehr reviewed with the Board the work to date on the project. Mr. Lehr informed the Board that the exterior building painting had been started. The paving of the walkways was scheduled for Friday, May 17, 2019. Dan Baggaley and Karen Corliss updated the group on the telephone/data line issues and possible solutions. Mr. Lehr noted that Mrs. Corliss would be contacting Stephen Fifield regarding performing the necessary work on the cupola. The necessary connections had been made to the generator. Mr. Lehr informed the group that Mr. Baggaley had completed the punch list and would be contacting the subcontractors to complete the work. The antennae had been installed for the Fire Chief on the back of the Academy Building. The concrete walls needed to be painted to the entrance of the LULA on all floors. Mr. Baggaley would work with the Tax Collector, Carol Bears, on getting the tax payment boxed moved from the old office to the new office. A discussion was held regarding getting a proposal for installing a water filtration system to address the iron issues. Once Consolidated Communications completes the installation on the phone for the elevator, the final tests can be performed by the State of NH Elevator Inspection. Mr. Baggaley discussed the number of phone lines required for the administration and number of lines for data. Mr. Hogan requested a copy of the punch list to review. The walkways are scheduled to be payed on Friday, May 17 by Bryant Paying. The electric on the Hebron Common will be checked so Irish Electric can address any issues.
